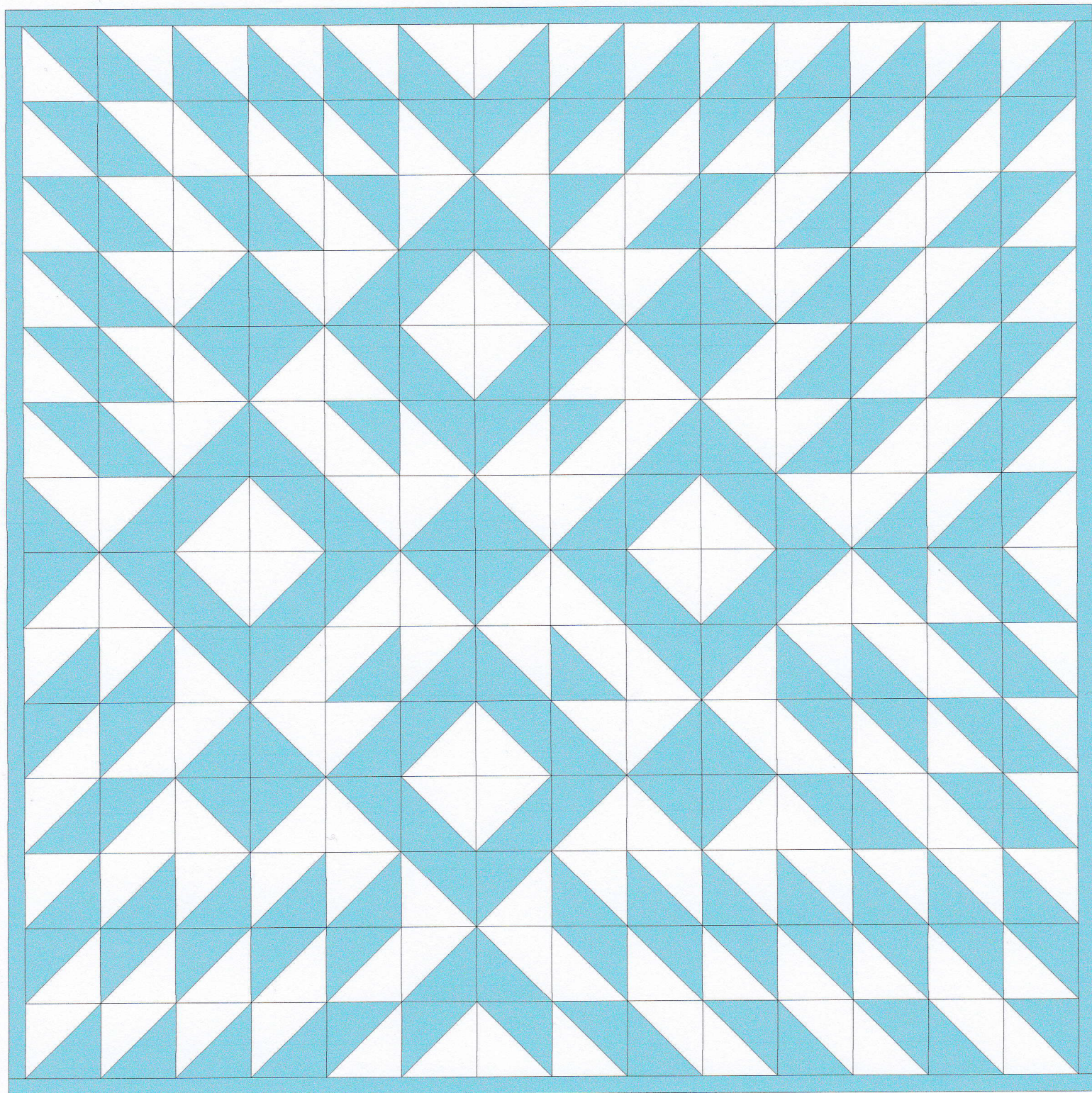


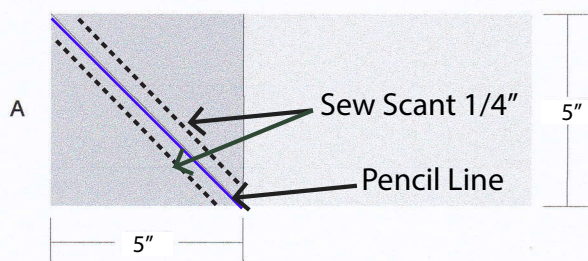
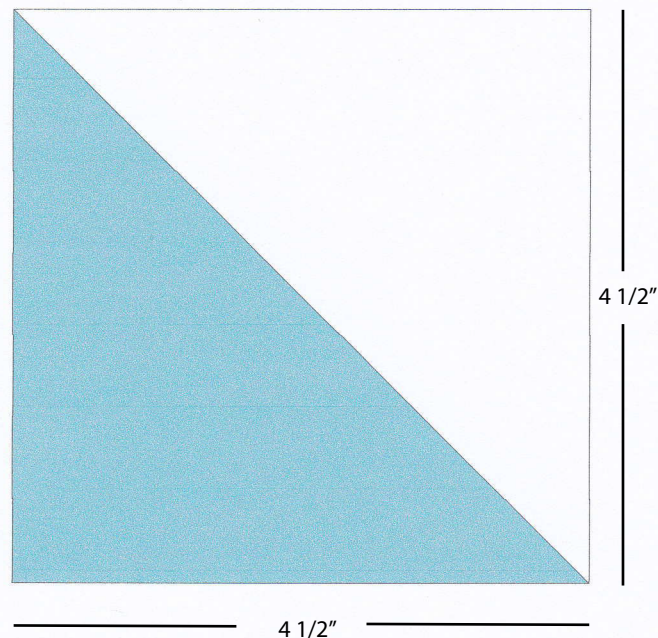
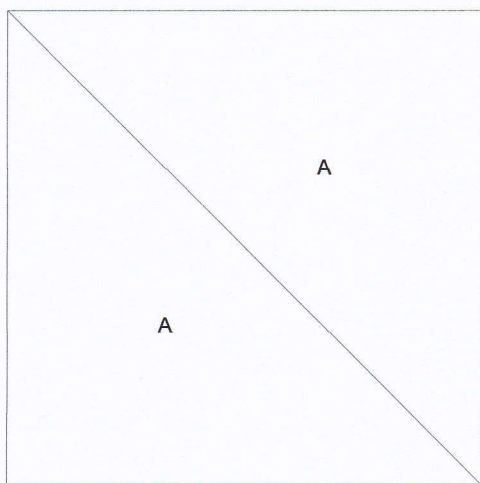


Snow Storm Quilt

Fabric width 44-45 inches	Number of patches	Yardage estimate	Fabric name SKU
	200	# 2 + 1/2 or (9 Fat Quarters)	Blue or whatever main color you choose.
	196	2 + 1/8 or (9 Fat Quarters)	White or a mixture of whites like I used in the video.

The estimate for this fabric assumes that long strips ARE pieced.

Directions to Construct Quilt Top

The way I constructed the quilt is I made the half square triangles with 5" squares using a scant 1/4" seam sewing a line along the center pencil line to make 2 half square triangles.

I ironed them about 3 quarters on the dark-side and about 1 quarter on the light side. Stack these in separate stacks to keep them apart . This is just a shortcut you can take so the construction goes smoother.

When you have all your pieces refer to the pattern picture, then use it to place the half square triangles in the order they appear.

Build the rows 2 at a time and sew the pairs to each other till then whole quilt top is finished.
