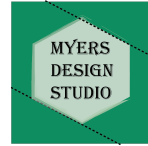


Wine Cozy

Cutting Instructions for non pieced version:

- Two 10 by 15" Outer Fabric
- Two 10 by 15" Lining Fabric
- Two 8 by 12 1/2" foam of your choice

Cutting Instructions for pieced version:

- Two 10 by 15" Lining Fabric
- Cut pieces of fabric to fit the 8 by 12 1/2" foam. You can use strips or any scraps you have available.
- Two 8 by 12 1/2" foam of your choice

Sewing Instructions:

Draw a line from on the top of the foam piece 1" at the top then draw a cutting line from the top to the bottom to form a trapezoid shape.

Now if you are using scraps cover the foam shape completely by using the quilt as you go method. If not using scraps, then place the 10 by 15" outer fabric on the foam and tack stitch it all around the outside 1/8".

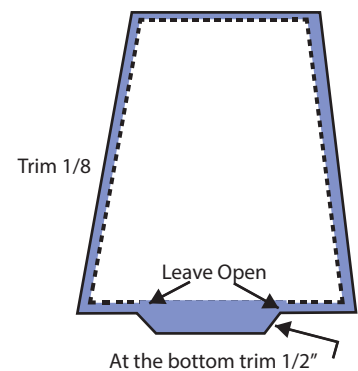
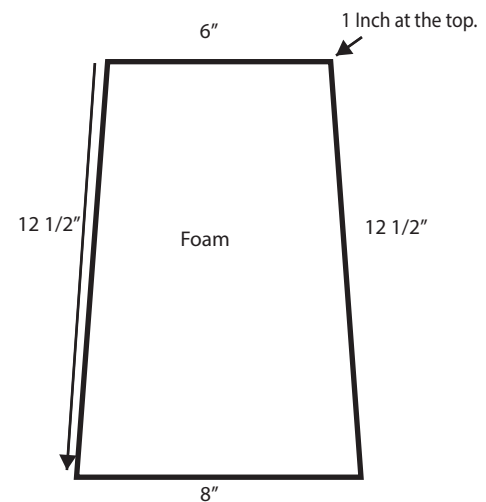
Next place the lining 10 by 15" facing the outer fabric. Begin stitching at the bottom leaving a place to turn later.

Stitch next to the foam but not on the foam.

Trim 1/8" on all sides. Except for the very bottom leave at least a half inch to turn the seam. Be careful not to cut the stitches.

Turn out the panel and iron flat. Iron the seam at the bottom to cover the foam.

Stitch the bottom closed.

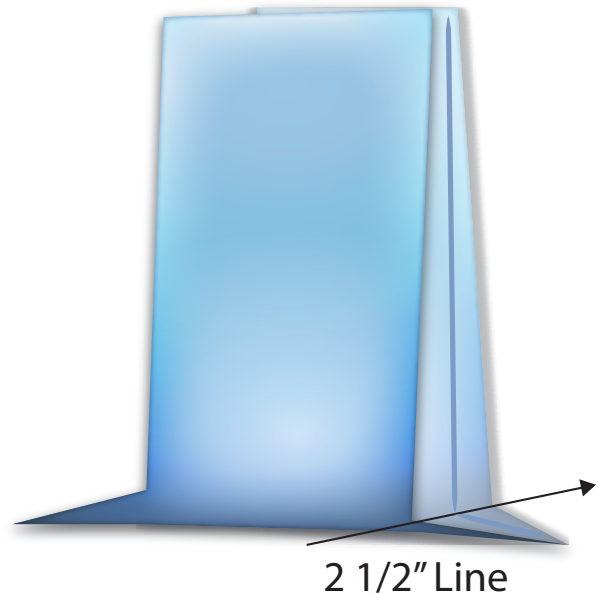


Now fold the corner down matching the center seam. Then measure 2 1/2" across and draw a line with a pencil or fabric marker.

Sew on the line with a large stitch.

Trim corner off.

Turn the wine cozy right side out.



Now you are done!
